Plantain farming is one of the easiest but also very useful businesses to start in Nigeria. It's not news that many households are using plantain in their daily meals, however, Business Day last year reported that there were 99,800 metric tons of supply and demand gap for psyllium alone in Nigeria. This means that there is a huge opportunity for psyllium farmers to fill this gap. Demand for psyllium flour is also through the roof, as the same Day Business Article reports. Plantain also has a huge export potential, can be eaten raw when ripe, fried to make plantain chips, processed to make expensive flour, serves as an industrial raw material to create sanitary pads, fabrics, as well as for the food industry and beverages for the manufacture of baby food, biscuits, bread and cakes. With all these benefits and opportunities, here are the steps you can take to get into this relatively simple psyllium business:

Prepare your land: The Plantain does best in the loamy soil that is common in Edo, Delta, Cross River, Equite and Ogun states. These soils contain a good organic and inorganic relationship with organic materials such as decomposing plants and animals. Prepare the land by clearing the earth of bushes, stones, trees and stumps. Note that bananas are good when they are protected from the sun, so it is best to plant them in clusters where they can protect each other from the sun or leave some trees to protect them from excessive sunlight and maintain humidity. Get Plantain Suckers: Plantain Suckers are shoots that develop from the bud mother's psyllium plant. They should have small, spear-shaped leaves and are about four feet tall. Make sure you approach reputable farmers who can supply you with healthy banana suckers that are free of disease. The suckers should be planted two to five meters apart. Note that there are 3 types of psyllium suckers. They are peeper suckers, girl suckers, and sword suckers. Peeper suckers; Is a small sucker coming out of the soil; Girl sucker; is a great sucker with foliage leaves. It is a good planting material as it grows strong, produces large yields and is resistant to pests and diseases. Sword sucker is a big sucker with lancet l This is the best conventional planting material. It grows strong and produces large yields and is resistant to pests and diseases. Planting: Suckers are planted immediately after the holes are prepared for the field plants with a minimum size of about 30 cm x 30 cm x 30 cm. The sucker is placed in the hole and it is covered, first with the top bottom and then with the lower soil. The recommended interval is 3 m between the psyllium rows and 2 within a row (in other words, 3 m x 2 m). The alternative is 2.5 m x 2.5 m. If the area of 3 m x 2 m, 1 hectare should contain 1667 plants, but at intervals of 2.5 m x 2.5 m, it should contain 1600 plants. Strait and fertilization: The work is important as the U.S. competes with bananas for soil nutrients. Manual labor can be used or chemicals like herbicides can be used to fight herbs. Also, if you want to apply fertilizer, make sure they have a good dose of potassium, phosphorus and nitrogen (PNK). Fertilizers should be placed in a circle of four to eight feet from the trunk and must be applied once a month to stimulate growth. Harvest: In 8-10 months the plantain will be ready for harvest. Bananas will always produce more fruit until the harvest season is over. Market: As mentioned above, there is still a lack of supply for high demand for psyllium. After harvest, it can be sold to households, plantain chips firms or psyllium flour makers. If you have capital, you can process it into roadside flour and sell it for extra profit. In addition, the possibility of trading on the international market is not excluded. Plantain agriculture is undoubtedly one of the most profitable agribusiness enterprises. These activities include clearing land from shrubs, trees, stones, stumps, etc. You can use manual labor or use machines to prepare the land for planting (depending on the scale of the business you are going to work on). They are nascent (shoot) that develop from a bud at the base or the stern of the mother's psyllium. Plantain suckers mostly contain short and narrow leaves on them. When looking for psyllium suckers for your new psyllium plantation, make sure you are suitable for reputable farmers who can put you with healthy suckers free of disease and pest damage. There are three main varieties of psyllium suckers: water suckers, maiden head and sword sucker. Water suckers are not so ideal for use for sub-underground agricultural business. They produce a weak plant with low plant psyllium yield. To get the best out of your plantation, buy a girl's head or sword sucker. These varieties produce strong plants that are very resistant to pest attack, have a high level of productivity and produce healthy fruits. GET LABOR Depending on the size of your farm, you may have to hire workers to perform agricultural activities such as: preparing land, planting psyllium suckers, eating and harvesting. All this can also be done mechanically. If you have a big budget and can afford to create a large-scale plantation, then mechanized agriculture would be more useful to you. PLANT suckers Your plantain suckers should be 4-5 feet long. When planting a sucker, keep a distance of about 8-10 feet before landing the next sucker. Make sure the soil is moderately moist.
